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NORD/LB issues Inaugural Senior Non-Preferred Benchmark Bond

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NORD/LB today successfully issued a Senior Non-Preferred bond in benchmark format. The term of the EUR 500 million bond, which trades under ISIN DE000NLB46Y6, is 5 years. The coupon is 3.625%, which corresponds to a premium of 120 basis points over mid-swaps. This is the bank's first issuance of a Senior Non-Preferred bond in benchmark size. The bond is rated "A1" by Moody's and "A+" by Fitch.

The transaction recorded solid demand on the capital market. The order book was opened on Tuesday morning and peaked at around EUR 1.2 billion (over 85 individual orders).

The majority of investors comes from Germany (51%) followed by the United Kingdom (15%) and France (13%). Investors from 17 countries bought the NORD/LB bond.

ABN AMRO, BBVA, BNP Paribas, BofA Securities, Deutsche Bank, and NORD/LB acted as joint lead managers for the transaction.
